


UAS REMOTE ID DEMONSTRATION

September 17, 2020 | Stafford/Quantico, VA

Briefing Book

This e-book includes relevant information and instructions for individuals attending the FAA's UAS Remote ID Broadcast Technology Demonstration on September 17, 2020. This demonstration will take place at Hogan's Alley in the FBI Academy on the Marine Corps Base Quantico. Suggested GPS address for attendees is 57 Bureau Parkway, Stafford, VA.



Please plan to arrive at the escort location <u>no later than 15 minutes prior</u> to the scheduled start of the session you are attending. Attendees are encouraged to arrive at the Marine Corps Base Vehicle Inspection gate up to <u>45 minutes prior to the start</u> time for processing through Marine Corps Base and FBI Academy's security gates.

Federal Government attendees <u>must</u> bring their Federal ID card (Common Access Card or PIV Card) for entry onto the Quantico Base.

Please <u>WEAR A FACE MASK</u> covering both your mouth and nose at all times after exiting your vehicle.

Driving Directions to the Demonstration Location:

1. Set your GPS destination to Stafford, VA. You will reach the Marine Corps

2. NON-FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ATTENDEES: If you do not have a Federal Government Issued Common Access Card (Federal ID Card), make a left on Telegraph Road and sign in at the Marine Corps Base Quantico Visitor Control Center (Game Check Station) prior to passing

Base Quantico Vehicle Inspection gate on Russell Road.

	through the Marine Corps Base gate.
	<u>FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ATTENDEES</u> : Show your Federal ID (CAC or PIV card) and tell the guard you are going to the FBI Academy.
3.	Continue following your GPS onto Camp Barrett Rd. TURN RIGHT onto Bureau Parkway.
4.	You will reach the FBI Academy Visitor Center (on your right). This is your last stop for a bathroom.
6.	After entering gate you will have your temperature taken and must respond to a brief health survey.
	*You will <u>NOT</u> be admitted to the Academy if you are running a fever or you have tested positive for COVID-19.
7.	Follow Bureau Pkwy, then TURN LEFT on Hoover Road.
8.	Follow Hoover Road. You will see a sign or person on your left directing you to a gravel road and a gravel parking lot next to a multi-story parking garage.
9.	Proceed to the sign-in table. Staff will be wearing navy FAA polo shirts.
10. At the end of the event you will be escorted as a group back to the parking garage.
